RE- Draft Master Plan 2009 - Lack of night curfew

Dear Madam/Sir,

As a long-term resident of North Canberra I would like to submit my concern over the lack of curfew in the draft Airport Master Plan.

Your proposal to take the advantage of Canberra's lack of night curfew to expand your economic advantage by opening Canberra airspace to freight flights that cannot fly into Sydney. The economic advantage gained by Canberra Airport will be at a disadvantage of the residents of Canberra.

Most Australian airports, in particular Sydney, have night curfew to protect their residents from aircraft noises including freights. Canberra residents have the right for protection against these noises also. Research has consistently shown that poor sleep leads to poor health. Canberra government and tax payer will carry the long-term health costs that the lack of curfew will have.
