Dear M/s Aves, My submission relates to the false and misleading information which has been promulgated in the dMP and on the airport website in relation to passenger and freight night time flights. Your reference on the website to noise abatement between 11.00pm and 6.00am is particularly deceptive, as it is intended to mislead and confuse residents into believing that a curfew will be in place. Of particular concern is the refusal of Noel MacCann to clarify the inconsistency between various conflicting accounts, within the dMP document, in statements at public presentations, and in statements on radio such as those of Stephen Byron on Sunday May 3, in relation to the number, time, nature, etc of night time flights. The picture is as clear as a Canberra airport pea soup fog on a winter's morning. Until such time as the inconsistency and obfuscation is eliminated, and there is introduced some transparency and veracity, it is impossible to assess the full impact of the airport's proposed night time aircraft operations. Accordingly your airport is advised to seek from the Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government, an extension of time of six months to enable you to tell the truth about your proposed operations and thus enable an opportunity for informed comment.
