Western Concourse Terminal at Canberra Airport Approved

Today the Minister for Transport, the Hon Anthony Albanese MP, gave his final approval for the development of the new Western Concourse Terminal at Canberra Airport.

Head of Aviation Business at Canberra Airport, Matthew Brown said:

“With this approval the Minister has endorsed Canberra Airport’s vision for the city’s new terminal, and we can now move forward with delivering a facility befitting the Nation’s Capital.”

Construction work on the Western Concourse Terminal is expected to commence later this year, following the completion of the new Southern Concourse Terminal in September 2010.

“Construction work at the Airport has been progressing at a rapid pace with the Pialligo Avenue upgrade and new 1200 space multi-storey car park already complete, and the new Southern Concourse Terminal now being fitted out by the airlines to take the first passengers in September”, said Mr Brown.
