

Governor General of Australia to open sculpture by world renowned Artist Ante Dabro

TODAY: Tuesday 2 June 2009 – 2.30pm

Her Excellency Quentin Bryce, the Governor General of Australia will today at 2.30pm (Tuesday 2 June), unveil *Genesis*, Ante Dabro's latest figurative sculpture.

This latest work *Genesis*, has been commissioned by Capital Airport Group and is Dabro's third piece to be located within Brindabella Business Park.

This sculpture is described as a;

'Symphony of forms and echoes the beginning of time. I sensed the site called for a composition of two. I wanted to create something where the harmony of shapes creates unity'
Dabro said.

Ante Dabro is a graduate of the Academy of Fine Arts in Zagreb, Croatia. He lectured in sculpture at the ANU School of Art from 1971 – 2004 and is one of the major advocates of figurative sculpture in Australia and worked on many commissions, including the Australian Naval Memorial on Anzac Parade in Canberra and the La Perouse Memorial in Paris.
